If all boxes checked **LOW**, check "No Insurance Documentation Required" box on next page and in Consultant Contract.

If one or more boxes checked **MEDIUM** or **MEDIUM HIGH**, but no **HIGH** and no items below are met, check "Standard Insurance."

If any trigger below is met, check box on next page: "NON-STANDARD" AND

If "AIRCRAFT" Risk Element box checked **MEDIUM** or **MEDIUM HIGH**, check "Aviation Liability" box on next page with minimum \$1,000,000 limit for **MEDIUM** or \$5,000,000 for **MEDIUM HIGH**.

If "WATERCRAFT" Risk Element box checked **MEDIUM HIGH**, check "Watercraft/P&I Liability" box on next page with minimum \$1,000,000 limit.

If "MARITIME WC" Risk Element box checked **MEDIUM HIGH**, check "Federal Maritime" and then "U.S. L.& H." boxes under "Federal Maritime" on next page.

If "ENVIRONMENTAL" Risk Element box checked **MEDIUM** or **MEDIUM HIGH**, check "Contractor's Pollution Liability" insurance with minimum \$1,000,000 limit and also check "Automobile Liability" for "MSC-90 and CA 99 48 endorsements."

The City expects to select an expert consultant to Implement Critical IT Processes which may include but will not be limited to:

- Develop and implement a one-city approach for requesting IT projects that is understood and trusted by City stakeholders. This approach may also align projects with department strategies and standards.
- Develop and implement a resource/capacity management function that maximizes use of IT staff and identifies potential gaps that could affect portfolio performance
- Develop processes and reports to manage the City IT project portfolio to mitigate risk and provide key stakeholders with visibility into performance
- Transform how Seattle IT helps other City Departments plan for IT projects and needs. Consultant may also, through the new Business Relationship Management (BRM) program, strategically enable the other user City Departments.
